

THE "I WILLS" OF PSALM 119

1. I WILL PRAISE THEE - Vs 7 - It is to this great end that the people of God are formed - Isaiah 43:2; Psm.63:3 ; Psm. 107:31,32: Psalm. 119;164 ; 1 Pet. 2:0; 4:11: The qualification for this praise is uprightness of heart - 1 Kings 3:6
2. I WILL OBSERVE THY STATUTES - Vs. 8 - *guard, protect, hedge about* See. Vs.11 - a heart right with God will have such an attitude. Deut. 6:6,7; Josh. 1:7-9; John 14: 15,23
3. I WILL MEDITATE IN THY PRECEPTS - Vs. 15,16 - Luke 2:19:
Ponder = guard, talk to my self about, consider deeply
4. I WILL DELIGHT MYSELF IN THY STATUTES S -16 - *fondle, lovingly Caress, amuse my self with.* Certainly surpasses some of what so many find Amusement in. today.
5. I WILL RUN THE WAY OF THY COMMANDMENTS - Vs. 32 - Those who 'observe, meditate and delight' in His Word will, of course, soon be found running in the way, with a heart greatly enlarged. "Following afar off" or "faint yet pursuing" is the condition of too many, sadly.
6. I WILL WALK AT LIBERTY - Vs. 45 - Sin is slavery. Those who give their will to Christ are free indeed (John. 8:32) Obedience to His Word is true liberty (John 8:34) Romans 6:16
7. I WILL SPEAK OF THY TESTIMONIES --AND NOT BE ASHAMED
Vs. 46 - Daniel 3:16-81; Romans 1:16; Mark 8:38
8. I WILL GIVE THANKS AT MIDNIGHT - Vs. 62 - Paul and Silas in the jail at Philippi - In the midnight of suffering; loss;
9. I WILL NEVER FORGET THY PRECEPTS - Vs. 93 - How could we forget those words which brought us light, life, security, confidence, purpose? Those words which guide us now - shall guide us through the valley of the shadow of death and will guide us for all eternity.
I will never forget thy words, because I will never forget Thee.
